PEP BOU stepped onto the stage as a professional in the second half of the seventies, one of the army of mimes so characteristic of this period. His studies in technical architecture and his passion for the fine and visual arts all came together into a deep feeling and love for ephemeral spaces and the malleability of shapes. His theatre background includes his period as a founding member of several companies (Pa de Ral, La Viu Viu Teatre), until he embarked on his risky venture into soap bubble theatre in 1982. This adventure has taken him onto the stages of theatres and festivals around the world, surprising and astonishing audiences of all ages and from all different cultural backgrounds. He has been honoured with a slew of prestigious prizes.
